The purpose of the Seed Money Scheme (SMS) is to assist projects, which contribute to the objective of student development at the Institute. The SMS provides funds for projects and initiatives that enrich the student community.

- To further inculcate research and technical writing skills in students, the Institute believes in supporting the student community towards publication of their work in journals of good repute viz Scopus indexed.
- The outcome of this leads to exposure to extra and co-curricular educational opportunities for students to build leadership, interpersonal, intrapersonal, citizenship awareness and/or community-building skills.

Norms for SMS


- 1. The Institute considers all In-house projects activities like PCB designing, PCB fabrication, component mounting, use of software, testing etc. for funding.
- Funding will be provided for hardware projects under project-based learning (PBL), mini projects and final year projects.

- 3. Seed money will be available as per the following guidelines,
 - **a. Final year projects:** 50 % of project component cost with a capping of 5,000/-maximum.
 - **b.** Project based learning (PBL) projects: 50 % of project component cost with a capping of 2,500/- maximum.
 - c. Mini projects: 50 % of project component cost with a capping of 2,500/-maximum.
- 4. The reuse of components needs to be considered whenever and wherever possible.
- 5. The Institute will provide the students 50 % of publication fee or 5,000/-, whichever is less to publish their paper in a Science Citation Index (SCI)/ Scopus Index journal. The amount is to be disbursed after the submission of the published paper to the department and article processing charges (APC) receipt to the accounts section.
- 6. The working of the project and its bills need to be verified by the respective project guide, project coordinator and authenticated by the Head of Department before processing the bills to Accounts section.
- 7. The bills with GST number need to be submitted to Accounts section before 25th February every year after the successful completion of the project. Bills will not be entertained after 25th February.
